Day Rates

There will be a daily fee of \$15/person for those who wish to come up but not spend the night. Day guests will be welcome at all meals served on that day. Due to the shortened hours, the day rate for 10/04 is \$10 and only dinner will be available. If you wish to be a Day Guest, please indicate the dates in the Notes below.

Check in/Check out

Check in will begin at 2pm on 10/04. You must check in with **Jon McLane** at the Dining Hall in order to get your room assignment. **No weapons or alcohol are allowed at Higher Ground. This is a facility policy, not a VoB policy.**

Inn Agape and Fairview Lodge

As stated on the registration form, rooms in Inn Agape and Fairview Lodge will be assigned first to families that are staying the full 9 nights on a first-come/first-served basis. In the event that multiple registrations for the full 9 nights are received at the same time, they will be assigned in alphabetical order according to last name until the rooms are filled. We are unable to fulfill exact room requests.

If a family is unable to stay for the full 9 nights, but wants to stay in either Inn Agape or Fairview Lodge, they may attempt to find another family that could stay in the same room on the dates that room would be unoccupied. For example, if a family is able to stay on 10/04-07, they may attempt to find another family that would take the same room for the nights 10/08-12 in order to fulfill the full 9 night stay parameter.

If we do not get enough full-term registrations, then we will attempt to assign rooms in such a way that would cause the rooms to be filled for as many nights as possible.

Individuals will be given the lowest priority in order to accommodate as many people per room as possible.

Sonshine House

There are 4 bunks per room. There will be no coed rooms unless shared by a family. Families may reserve a whole room at a reduced rate of \$30/night. Individuals may reserve a room at \$30/night, however, in the event that the facility is fully booked, they may be assigned a roommate of the same sex and their rate will be reduced to the normal bunk rate of \$10/night and the overage will be refunded.

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Occupancy

Rooms are assigned on a first-come/first-served basis. In the event that a requested building is full, we will offer a room in the other building to the families affected at the rate for that particular building, which may result in an increased cost. For example, if a family requests Fairview Lodge (\$30/night) but it is full, they will be offered an available room in Inn Agape, which is \$40/night. If both Inn Agape and Fairview are full, bunks in the Sonshine House will be offered.

Camping

Primitive Tent Camping only. There are electrical hookups near the campsites by the Sonshine house, but campers need to provide their own extension cords. Please see **Jon McLane** before setting up your tent/equipment so that the location can be approved. **No cookware or fires are allowed.** Campers will be allowed to access the showers and bathrooms in the Sonshine House.

Meals

There will be three community meals per day with 10/04 (check-in) and 10/13 (check-out) being the exceptions. Outside food is strongly discouraged due to very limited refrigerator space. There will be no access to the kitchen by anyone except those scheduled to serve during a particular meal, Higher Grounds Staff or the Leadership Team. **If you bring outside food for a particular meal, you must eat it in a location outside the dining hall. The dining hall is reserved for those who have paid for that particular meal.** We understand that people may have particular dietary needs. Please indicate them on the registration form so that we may attempt to accommodate them. Snacks are allowed, but must be stored with the individual that brings them.

Payment

Payment is due in full upon submission of the registration form. The registration will not be processed without payment. Please make all checks out to **Valley of Blessing**. **Electronic payments are not available for this event.**
